W. E. Venters reported that Mr. Kimberlain, of the State Highway Department would be here early next week to see the City Manager and Chief of Police for the purpose of making a complete survey of traffic conditions.

The committee on Traffic consists of the Mayor, B. P. Bogardus, Chief of Police and the City Manager.

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The City Manager reported that the City Attorney had written a letter to all trucking companies concerned, about the soon to be enacted ordinance of the City of Pikeville restricting the parking of tractor trailer strucks. The purpose of the letter is to give the companies time to make necessary arrangements.

R. G. Wells, Jr. directed the City Attorney to see about getting the parking situation at Court House Square cleared up.

The committee for Budget Review consists of Bruce Walters, the Mayor, City Manager and City Clerk. The purpose of the committee is to bring expenses in line with revenues.

R. G. Wells moved to take no action to abolish the practice that the Fire Department is not to answer calls outside City Limits excepting in answering the call of another Fire Department. W. E. Venters seconded the Motion. Vote was as follows:
