Also present were City Manager, W. E. Butcher and City Attorney, O. T. Hinton.

The City Clerk read the minutes of the January Meetings.

Mayor Hambley directed the City Attorney O. T. Hinton to report on the matter concerning Hubert Maynard.

The City Attorney said that the City Manager had experienced difficulties with Hubert Maynard, a policeman on January 26, 1965, but that because of illness of Mr. Butcher's brother the City Attorney had not been informed immediately. Mr. Hinton said that on the direction of the Mayor, the City Attorney prepared a citation against Maynard notifying him to appear at a hearing on February 1, 1965, to answer a charge of insubordination and conduct unbecoming an officer and to show cause why he should not be discharged from the police force. However the hearing was postponed until 7:30 P.M. February 8, 1965.

Mr. Hinton said that after a conference with Maynard's attorney, he decided that it was to the best interest of all concerned if the citation be dropped. Mr. Hinton therefore recommended that the hearing be dropped.

Harry Hobson made the motion to accept the City Attorney's Recommendation. Uhlan Taylor seconded the motion and upon roll call the vote was as follows:
