#### RESOLUTION

It appearing that the City of Pikeville has heretofore organized an airport board known as Pikeville-Pike County Airport Board in conjunction with Pike County and it further appearing that the Fiscal Court of Pike County and the officials of Pike County have failed and refused to cooperate with the City or contribute to the financial needs of the Board in acquiring the property and funds necessary to provide airport facilities for this community and that everything that has been done so far to that end has been done thru the efforts and activity of the City and its officials.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the City Attorney be authorized to take such steps as maybe necessary to disassociate the City from Pike County in the furtherance of the Airport Board if that is legally possible and report his action thereunder to the next meeting of this board.
