

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pikeville, Kentucky held in City Hall June 6, 1966 at 7:30 p. m. the following were present:

The City Clerk read the minutes of the May meetings.

Charles E. Spears, Superintendent of Pikeville City Schools reported on the status of the construction on the new school. Mr. Spears also inquired about water and sewer service to the new school.

City Manager W. E. Butcher recommended the following resolution.

RESOLUTION

Be it resolved that the City Manager be authorized to install temporary water and sewer facilities to the school on Chloe Creek in time to open school on August 22, 1966.
