MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE HELD AT CITY HALL ON JULY 25, 1966 AT 7:30 P.M. met pursuant to adjournment, the roll call was as follows: W. C.
