

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pikeville held in the City Hall on July 3, 1967, at 7:30 P. M. the following were present:

Kermit Sexton moved to authorize the Pike County Chamber of Commerce to put a Tourist Information Center on the By-Pass Road at no expense to the City, with the understanding that the unit would be a mobile unit and that it evacuate on 30 days notice for any use the City finds for the property or any work that the City needs to do on said property.
