At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pikeville held on July 19, 1968 at 7:30 P.M. in City Hall, the following were present:

Venters, City Attorney presented an ordinance entitled AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX LEVY ON ALL REAL, TANGIBLE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, FRANCHISES, BANK SHARES AND LEVING A POLL TAX, ALL FOR GENERAL OPERATING EXPENSE PURPOSES AND PROVIDING FOR A DISCOUNT ON ALL TAXES PAID ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1, 1968, AND A PENALTY IF NOT PAID BY DECEMBER 31, 1968, to the Commission.
