

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pikeville held on October 18, 1968 at 7:30 P.M. in City Hall the following were present:

The Mayor presented the following order to the Commission:

RE: PIKEVILLE-PIKE COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD

It appearing that be order of the Fiscal Court entered on September 1st, 1968, appearing in Order Book 15, Page 548, the creation of a joint airport board pursuant to the provisions of what was then K.R.S. 183.370 was approved and it further appearing that there is now a vacancy to be filled by the joint appointment of the County Judge of Pikeville County and the Mayor of the City of Pikeville under the provisions of K.R.S. 183.132-(3)-(C)-being Section 5 of Chapter 134 of the Acts of 1964, and it appearing that there is one (1) vacancy created by the resignation of Walter E. May, whose term expired September 1st, 1969. Daryl Ratliff is hereby appointed to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Walter E. May and to serve out the unexpired term of said Walter E. May.

Upon expiration of the term of Daryl Ratliff, his successor shall be appointed for a period of four (4) years in the manner provided by the afore-said section of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.
