RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK
TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR PURCHAS OR
LEASE OF AN AUTOMOBILE FOR USE BY THE
POLICE DEPARTMENT AS A POLICE CRUISER

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of Pikeville is in need of an automobile to use as a police cruiser in the performance of the duties of said department,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Clerk is hereby directed and authorized to advertise for bids for purchase or lease and said advertisement shall provide for the acquisition thereof by either purchase or lease, to be determined by the Board of Commissioners of one 1970 four sedan automobile, with an eight cylinder motor; with not less than 350 cubic inches or more than 410 cubic inches; heavy duty alternator and generator; and heater, power brakes and steering. Said automobile is to be used as a police cruiser by the Police Department of the City of Pikeville.

2. An emergency exists and this resolution shall be effective immediately.

(2) Proposed amendment of Article VI, Section 601 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Pikeville, adding to "Uses Permitted" in C-1 Highway Commercial Zones the following: (1) Medical Facilities - This notice is given pursuant to Article XV of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Pikeville, said proposals having previously been approved by the Pikeville Planning Commission.
