Rutherford is hereby designated as a policeman of the City of Pikeville with all the powers and responsibilities in connection therewith to serve for such period he shall remain in the employ of Pikeville College, Inc. as a guard until he resigns or is removed by operation of law or until he is removed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pikeville.
- 2. The agreement dated November ______, 1969, by and between Pikeville College, Inc. and the City of Pikeville is hereby approved and the Mayor of the City of Pikeville is authorized to sign and execute same on behalf of the City of Pikeville and the Clerk is directed to attest same and place the City seal thereon.
