At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pikeville Kentucky held on May 25, 1970 at 7:30 P.M. in City Hall the following were present.

City Manager, Ike Hall and the City Attorney John Cline III were also present.

The Meeting began with the reading of the minutes of the past two meetings, there was no corrections or additions and having voiced no objections from the Commissioners, the Mayor declared the minutes approved as read.

The floor was opened to the public for discussion, which began with Mr. *Chrisman* who brought up the Middle Bowles Addition, to install gas and water, there was some discussion about the matter and the Commission decided to review the plans and would make a decision in the near future.

The following Resolution was presented and read before the Commission.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MODEL CITY AGENCY FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE TO CONTRACT WITH BOBBY JOHNSON CONTRACTOR OF ALEXANDRIA LOUISIANA, FOR REMOVAL OF CERTAIN BUILDINGS FROM LOUISIANA TO PIKEVILLE.

The City Commission of the City of Pikeville hereby deem it advisable that the Model City Agency contract with Bobby Johnson, Contractor, for the dismantling, bundling and loading of army huts to be transported to Pikeville, Kentucky; *bun*

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE:

1. that the Model Cities Agency for and in behalf of the City of Pikeville is hereby authorized to contract with Bobby Johnson, Contractor, of Alexandria, Louisiana for the latter to dismantle, bundle and load onto gondola railroad cars, buildings 1305, 1321, 811, and 812. Further, to rough grade and clean areas under and around these existing buildings and to remove concrete slab under building 827, to clean and rough grade the area under and around this dismantled building.

2. that the Contract price shall not exceed \$13,557.00 with \$5,000.00 of this amount to be paid upon removal of the first two building measuring 40' x 100' together with the removal of concrete slabs and cleaning up of this area. The balance to be paid upon dismantling, bundling, and loading of the remaining buildings.



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3. that the director of the Model City Agency, William Turner, Jr. is hereby authorized to subscribe and execute this contract.

The City Commissioners of the City of Pikeville deem it advisable to rent a billing machine, so that billings, from the City Manager's Office may be expedited.

that the City Manager, Ike Hall, is hereby authorized to enter in a contract with the Burroughs Corporation to lease a billing machine for a period of three years at a machine rental of \$263.00 per month.

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A PROPOSAL AND TAX BUDGET FOR A NURSING EDUCATION PROGRAM, BOTH ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS ITEMS "A" AND "B"

WHEREAS: the City of Pikeville has embarked upon a Model City Program for the improvements of living and service conditions for the people of the area.

WHEREAS: One of the components of the Model City Program is directed toward the improvement of nursing services in the medical community.

WHEREAS: Sufficient Model City funds have been allocated for this purpose during the first year implementation ending September 30, 1970.

WHEREAS: Negotiations have been completed for the establishment of an Associate Degree Nursing Program with work-study addition involving Eastern Kentucky



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University, Pikeville College, Methodist Hospital as the Pikeville Hospital and the Model City Agency in a Cooperative program.  
WHEREAS: Eastern Kentucky University being the degree awarding authority and planner of the program and having submitted a contract for such program and budget for peroid June 1, 1970 to September 30,1970 in the amount of \$12,272.00.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE THAT THE PROPOSAL AND ATTACHED BUDGET AS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AT ITEMS "A" AND "B" ARE HEREBY APPROVED BY THIS COMMISSION:
