THOUSAND-DOLLARS (\$9,000.00) FROM DEPARTMENT OF HUD TO THE CITY OF  
PIKEVILLE WITH ATTENDIVE REVISED BUDGET ATTACHED.

WHEREAS the City of Pikeville has executed a Grant Agreement with the  
United States dated October 27, 1969 under which the United States agreed to  
assist the city in carrying out its comprehensive City demonstration program  
and certain projects and activities listed in the Grant Budget of the Grant  
Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of  
Pikeville that:

SEC. 1 The Program is hereby amended as reflected in Exhibit A. attach-  
ed hereto and made a part hereof.

The foregoing resolution is true and correct copy of the resolution as fin-

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A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS ATTACHEMENT "A" BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE PIKEVILLE CITY DEMONSTRATION AGENCY, AND THE BIG SANDY COMMUNITY ACTION PROGRAM, INCORPORATED.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Pikeville deem it advisable that the City of Pikeville, for and in behalf of the Pikeville City Demonstration Agency, to contract with Big Sandy Community Action Program, Incorporated, in order that repairs may be made on Euclid Bulldozer Transmission, said dozer presently being used for training purposes in the Heavy Equipment Training Program; these repairs are not to exceed \$4,325.18.

The Board of Commissioners further deem it advisable that the Mayor of the City of Pikeville, William C. Hambley, be authorized to execute this contract for the City of Pikeville, and for and in behalf of the Pikeville City Demonstration Agency.

WHEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE HEREBY RESOLVE:

1. that the contract attached hereto and made a part hereof as Attachment "A": by and between the City of Pikeville, for and in behalf of the Pikeville City Demonstration Agency, and Big Sandy Community Action Program, Incorporated, is hereby approved, and the Mayor of the City of Pikeville, William C. Hambley, is hereby authorized to execute the same;

2. an emergency exists; therefore, this Resolution is to be in full force and effect immediately upon approval and acceptance by these Commissioners.

The meeting was opened with the presentation of the following resolution:  
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO CONTRACT FOR A LOAN FROM THE CITIZENS BANK OF PIKEVILLE IN THE SUM OF \$6,341.00 TO PURCHASE A GARBAGE TRUCK AND PACKER.

The City Commissioners of the City of Pikeville hereby deem it advisable to authorize the City Clerk, Charles Huffman, Jr., to borrow from the Citizens Bank of Pikeville the sum of \$6,341.00 payable over a period of 24 months in order to purchase a garbage truck and packer.

All principal and interest on this loan are to be paid from the City of Pikeville's Garbage Fund.

THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE RESOLVE:

(1) that the City Clerk, Charles Huffman, Jr., is hereby authorized to contract for a loan from the Citizens Bank of Pikeville to the City of Pikeville in the amount of \$6,341.00 payable over 24 months in order to purchase a garbage truck and packer for the City of Pikeville;
