At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on November 23, 1970, at 7:30 P.M. in City Hall at Pikeville, Kentucky the following were present.

The Meeting began with the opening of the Bids for the Sidewalk replacement on Cline Street, which take about 345 feet of new payment. City Manager, Ike Hall had two bids which were opened and they were as follows:

2. Barb & Ass. 1940.00

Neither bid was accepted because of the failure of explanation of the specifications Commissioner directed Mr. Hall to rewrite specification and advertise for bids again.

Commission wanted to know if City Manager, Ike Hall, or John Cline made any progress with Adams Construction Company concerning the Judgement. John Cline stated that he was unable to contact Mr. Adams to make an settlement. After some discussion between the Mayor and the City Manager, motion was made by Warren Keene to go ahead and pay the final payment of \$33,170.88 this was then seconded by Frank Justice and upon roll call the vote was as follows:
