After some discussion it was agreed by both parties that the Attorneys on both sides should meet in session and make some agreements or settlements.

City Attorney brought before the Commission the fact that Stewart Adams had made an agreement to pay the City of Pikeville \$10,000.00, there was some discussion about this agreement and it was agreed by the Commission that the City would accept the \$10,000.00 and bill Adams with the two (2) months of gas used, and in the new Contract Adams would pay the new rates set up by the Commission.

City Commissioner John Bill Trivette made the motion to settle with Adams in this way on our terms and seconded by Commissioner Warren Keene and upon roll call the vote was as follows:

WHEREAS, the regional Model Cities Office in Atlanta has recommended that the Pikeville CDA proceed with necessary expenditures for program administration and continuation of existing projects.

WHEREAS, the CDA will need to amend existing contracts of all existing continuing projects to extend these contracts from date of termination for a peroid of thirty (30) days.

- 1. that the CDA is authorized to proceed the continuation of program administrative and existing continuing project cost necessary expenditures of unspent funds of first action year.
- 2. that the CDA is authorized to amend all existing continuing project contracts to extend these contracts for a peroid of thirty (30) days from date of termination.
