considerable discussion on the matter, the City Attorney was instructed by the Commission to work up a meets and bounds description and to include the area south of Pikeville to the boundaries of the Independent School System and prepare an Ordinance to be presented at the next meeting. John Doug Hays representing the City Attorney said this ordinance would have to be passed and advertised for three weeks and an annexation suit filed in the Circuit Court. The Commission asked several residents of the area how most of the people felt about annexation. Mrs. Gertrude Johnson said she had talked with residents of this area and everyone she had talked with favored annexation.

Mrs. J. E. Bowman came before the Commission concerning the Half Way House on College Street. She complained that even though the State Fire Marshall had not approved the building and the necessary permits had not been obtained, two people (alcoholics) were already residing there. The Commission instructed Chief May and Fire Chief Smith to go to the buildin g and check to see if it conforms to the State Fire Marshall's requirements. The Chief of Police was further instructed to see if Roscoe Cavins and Roy Blair are residing here and to make sure that no operations as a centerof instruction are going on until all the State Fire Marshall's specifications have been met. After discussion, it was decided that the Fire Department would handle the situation and Chief Bob May would assist.

Commissioner Kermit Sexton made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner W. E. Butcher seconded the motion. Upon roll call, the vote was as follows:
