

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Pikeville was held on August 23, 1982 at 7:30 P.M. in their Regular Meeting Place in the Old City Hall Meeting Room on Division Street.
