

# MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

## REGULAR MEETING - SEPTEMBER 27, 1982

A Regular Meeting was held by the Pikeville City Commission on September 27, 1982 at 7:00 P.M. in the Old City Hall Meeting Room.

At 7:00 P.M. a work session was held between the Pikeville City Commission and Howard K. Bell Consulting Engineers concerning the financial feasibility of selling bonds to finance new sewer lines.

At 7:30 P.M., the regular session was called to order with the following Commission members present:

The minutes were read for the previous regular meeting of September 13, 1982 and were approved as read.

Thelmer McClanahan was present to ask the Commission if he could place stone in behind the Church of Christ on Main Street on the riverbank. Larry Webster, City Attorney, explained that Mr. McClanahan would have to go through the Urban Renewal Agency to obtain a permit to put anything on the riverbank.

It was also asked of the Commission to allow burning of old wood, etc., behind the Church on the riverbank. The Commission directed the gentleman to get authorization from the Fire Chief, Charles T. Smith.

Glenn McDowell was present to ask the Commission to reinstall 62 feet of sidewalk on Third Street in front of Kenny Childers house, that had been torn out by his contractors (Kenny Childers) when remodeling his house.

Basil Armstrong was present from Pikeville College to ask the Commission if they could continue to use the facilities at Poor Farm Hollow for ball practice and if they could work something out so they could use the Athletic Field. It was stated that Mr. Armstrong would have to speak with Hillard Howard, Park Supervisor, to see if something could be worked out.

A list of City Bill totaling \$181,928.76 was presented to the Commission for approval of payment. Included in these bills was a bill in the amount of \$10,400.82 for the Appalachian News Express.
