Resolution R-82-027 was presented to the Commission and was read entitled:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DISCOUNTS AND PENALTIES ON PAYMENT OF PROPERTY TAXES IN CITY OF PIKEVILLE

WHEREAS, the City of Pikeville has traditionally offered discounts for early property tax payment and imposed penalties for late payment, and

WHEREAS, because of circumstances beyond the control of the city, tax bills were not timely



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printed and the discount and penalty information contained thereupon is incorrect,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that if property taxes are paid before Dec. 1, 1982, that the allowance of a 2% discount is approved, retroactively. If taxes are paid after Dec. 1, 1982 and before Jan. 1, the face amount of the tax bill will be collected. If paid after Jan. 1, 1983, a 10% penalty will be added to the tax bill.
