

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

CONTINUED MEETING - March 13, 1984

A continued meeting of the Board of Commissioners for the City of Pikeville was held on March 13, 1984 at 3:00 p.m. in the second floor conference room at City Hall.

Mayor W. C. Hambley, M.D. presided over the meeting. When roll was called, the following members were present:

A bill was presented to the Commission from C & C Contracting for labor and materials for the 1384 Bridge repair project. The bill totaled \$16,177.50. Harding Dawahare made the motion to approve payment of the bill. Robert Page seconded the motion. The motion carried 5 - 0.

Two bills were submitted to the Commission for approval of payment at \$45.00 each for Jim Forsythe and Mike Cornette (Codes Inspector and Fire Inspector) to attend a class given by the National Certification Program for Construction Codes Inspectors. Robert Page made the motion to approve payment of these bills. Rush Dye seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Discussed, but no action taken, were problems that the Public Works Department is having when washing the streets at night. Cars are still parked after notice was given that the streets would be washed. It was suggested that an ad be placed in the newspaper telling the dates the streets would be washed and to have the cars off the street; put a note on the car; and as a final resort, have the Chief of Police to have the cars towed.

Also discussed was the need for an additional fireman. Applicants to fill this position were discussed, but no action was taken.

Harding Dawahare made the motion to adjourn the meeting and go into a work session. Robert Page seconded the motion. Upon call of the roll, the motion carried as follows:
