

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

SPECIAL MEETING - OCTOBER 10 1985

The Pikeville City Commission was called to met in a Special Session on October 10 1985 in the regular meeting place of said Board in the Old City Hall Meeting Room on Division Street.

As required by law, Special Meeting Notices were served 24 hours in advance and all media were notified of the meeting.

The meeting was called for two purposes:

1. Consider employing a Water & Sewer Consultant
2. Consider employing a Natural Gas Department Consultant

W. C. Hambley, M.D., Mayor, called the meeting to order. The following members were present upon the 9:00 a.m. roll call:

Gary Layne presented his proposal for analysis and maintenance program for the water and sewer distribution system. The fee for a 2 week investigation is \$2,000.00 Any other required time would be \$200.00/day. Mr. Layne feels that 2 days per month would be all that is required. Mr. Layne also requested records to review and full office cooperation. Harding Dawahare made the motion to employ Gary Layne as water & sewer consultant based upon the city attorney reviewing the contract. Frank Morris seconded the motion. The motion carried 3 - 0.

Dennis Roark was not present.

There being no further business to bring before the Commission, Harding Dawahare made the motion, seconded by Frank Morris to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
