

# MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

## REGULAR MEETING - JUNE 23, 1986

The Pikeville City Commission met in their regularly scheduled meeting on June 23, 1986 in the Old City Hall Meeting Room on Division Street.

Mayor W. C. Hambley, M.D. called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. The following members were present and formed a quorum:

The minutes for the previous regular meeting of June 9, 1986 were included in each Board Member's agenda package. Robert Page made the motion, seconded by Frank Morris to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion carried unanimously.

In Business from the floor, the City Commission heard a request from Ronnie Rich of the Pikeville Sanitation Crew for additional uniforms and 10 hour paid holidays versus the 8 hours paid holidays. Mr. Carlton, City Manager, will review the request and report back to the City Commission.

In other business from the floor, the City Commission gave permission for another access to be reconstructed on Cline Street to serve the "Pampered Pets Store". David Choat will present this request to the State for their approval.

David Choat, representative of Summit Engineering, gave the city engineer's report. Mr. Choat reported that bids had been opened for repairs & painting of the Road Fork and Peach Orchard Water Tanks. The low bidder for both projects was W & O Construction. Road Fork Tank was bid at \$30,719.00 for wax coating and Peach Orchard was bid at \$15,700.00 for wax coating. Mr. Choat explained that wax coating of the inside of the tanks was more effective than epoxy painting due to the age of the tanks. Mr. Choat recommended awarding both contracts to W & O Construction, but to hold the work order on the Peach Orchard Tank until temporary water can be supplied. The motion was made by Robert Page, seconded by Greg Justice to award the bid for repairs and painting of the Road Fork and Peach Orchard Tanks to W & O Construction and for Summit Engineering to provide inspection a year from the date of completion. The motion carried unanimously.

Upon motion by Robert Page and seconded by Greg Justice, the motion carried unanimously to construct a 25 foot service entrance for Continental Interiors at a cost of approximately \$900.00.

The Commission, upon motion by Robert Page and seconded by Greg Justice, voted unanimously to approve an emergency contract with James Kreutzer to raise the gas well and repair the casing. The City reserves the right to be reimbursed for the \$11,000+ cost when a determination is made on who is at fault.

City Bills totaling \$116,823.53 were presented to the Commission for approval of payment. Frank Morris made the motion, seconded by Greg Justice to approve payment as submitted. The motion carried unanimously.

Project Bills in the amount of \$17,299.19 were presented to the Board for approval of payment. Robert Page made the motion, seconded by Robert Weddle to approve payment as requested. The motion carried unanimously.

An Ordinance was brought before the Commission and given second reading. The Ordinance was read entitled:

ORDINANCE INCREASING SEWER TAP FEE (C-1)

Robert Page made the motion, seconded by Greg Justice to adopt the Ordinance. The motion carried unanimously.



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A Resolution was brought before the Commission and read entitled:

RESOLUTION RENAMING 264 HIGH STREET THROUGH 281 HIGH STREET "SAAD AVENUE" 0'

Robert Page made the motion, seconded by Robert Weddle to adopt the Resolution. The motion carried unanimously.

Frank Morris made the motion, seconded by Greg Justice to schedule the Zoning Ordinance Public Hearing on July 18, 1986 at 7:00 P.M. in the Power Company Auditorium. The motion carried 4 - 1 with Robert Page voting "NO".

The Commission scheduled a Budget Work Session for July 7, 1986 at 3:00 P.M. in the City Hall Conference Room.

Robert Weddle made the motion, seconded by Robert Page to adjourn to closed session to discuss personnel matters. The motion carried unanimously.

Robert Page made the motion, seconded by Robert Weddle to reconvene the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Frank Morris made the motion to authorize a temporary hiring of a Water Treatment Plant Trainee. Robert Weddle seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Greg Justice made the motion, seconded by Robert Page to study a proposal to remodel the old Railroad Depot for City Hall Offices. The motion carried unanimously.

Robert Page made the motion to adjourn. Greg Justice seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
