

MINUTES } CITY OF PIKEVILLE

SPECIAL MEETING - AUGUST 3, 1988

The Pikeville City Commission held a specially called meeting on Wednesday, August 3, 1988 at their regular meeting place at the City Hall Public Meeting Room at 260 Hambley Boulevard.

The announcement of the Special Meeting was made during a work session on August 2, 1988 with representatives of the local news media present. The Special Meeting Notices were served on August 3, 1988.

Mayor W. C. Hambley, M.D. called the meeting to order at 5:10 p.m. The following Commission Members were present and formed a quorum. Those present upon call of the roll were:

Greg Justice made the motion, seconded by Steve Combs to adjourn to an executive session to discuss the City Manager position. The motion carried unanimously.

Greg Justice made the motion to reconvene to regular session. Steve Combs seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Steve Combs made the motion to approve a contract to employ Carl Keyser as interim City Manager for six months under terms and conditions as disclosed to the City Attorney. Greg Justice seconded the motion. The motion carried 4 - 1 with Mayor Hambley voting "NO"

Greg Justice made a motion, seconded by Steve Combs to adjourn to executive session with Housing Authority Executive Director, Pat Wagner, to discuss the proposed new garbage rates. The City Attorney advised the Commission this was not legal cause for Executive Session and the motion was withdrawn.

Following a great deal of discussion with Ms. Wagner concerning the garbage rates, Greg Justice made the motion, seconded by Thomas Huffman to table the matter until Mr. Keyser, the new City Manager, had an opportunity to talk with the Regional Housing and Urban Development officials to determine the amount of increase in rates they would permit the Housing Authority to pay for residents of the Low Income Housing Units. The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss, Greg Justice made the motion, seconded by Steve Combs to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
