 FRANK JUSTICE, II

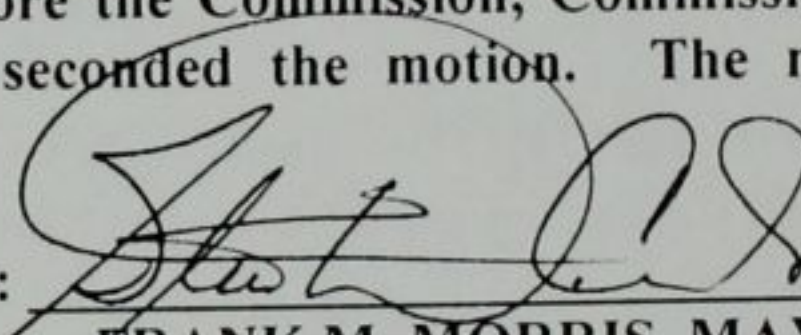

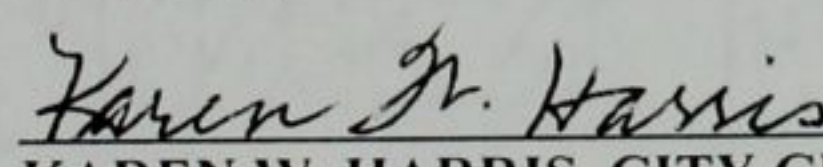
