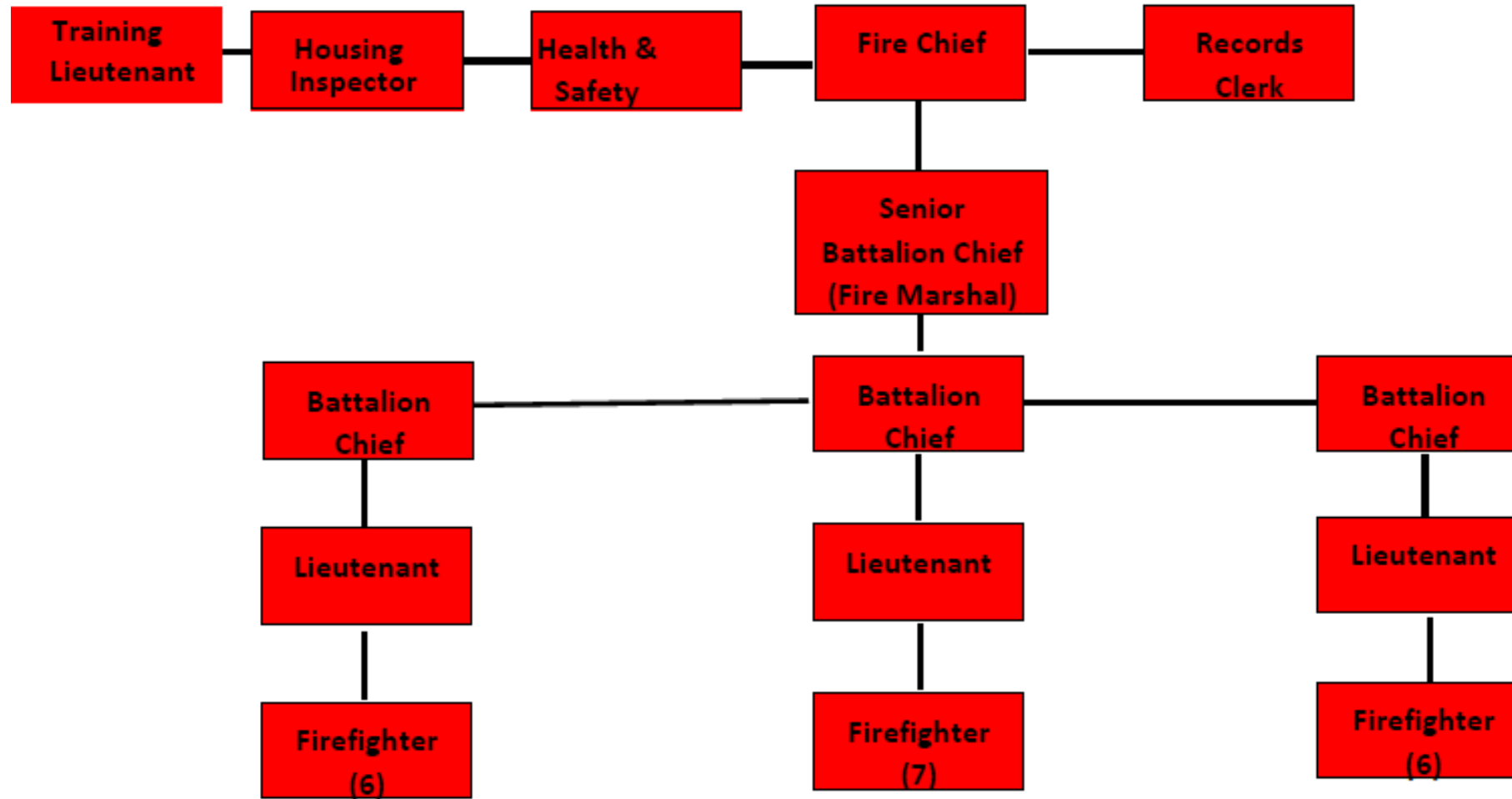

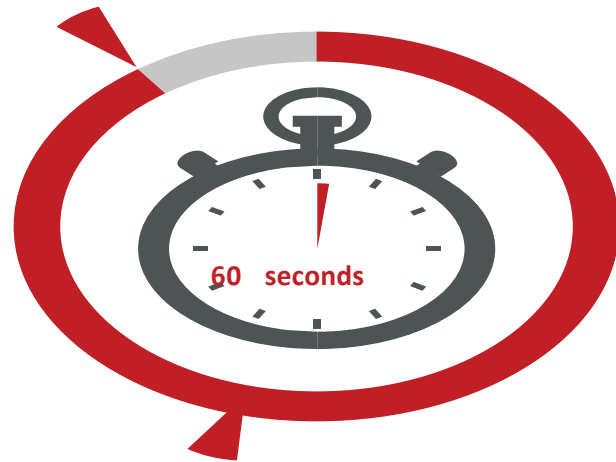

EMS 2021 RESPONSE TIME STANDARDS

EMS TURNOUT TIME

Definition: from the time of alarm to the time unit is en route.

Standard is 60 seconds, 90% of the time.

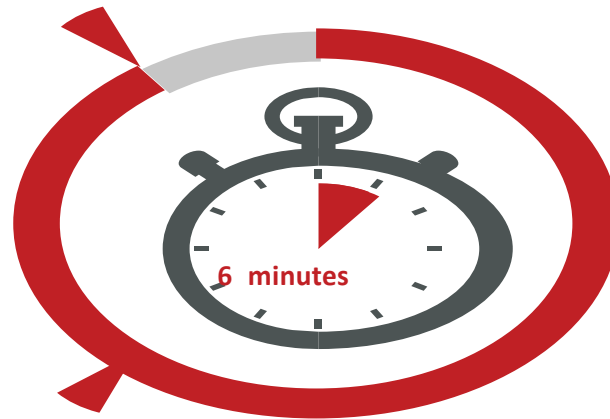


ACTUAL: 44 % OF THE TIME

EMS BASIC LIFE SUPPORT TOTAL RESPONSE TIME

Definition: from the time of alarm to the time of arrival.

Standard is 6 minutes, 90% of the time.



ACTUAL: 66 % OF THE TIME

FIRE 2021 RESPONSE TIME STANDARD

FIRE FIRST ARRIVING

ENGINE AT A FIRE – 50%

Definition: from the time of alarm to the time of arrival.

Standard is 6 minutes, 90% of the time.

In 2021 response time standards were met and
Department average was 3 minutes and 30 secs.

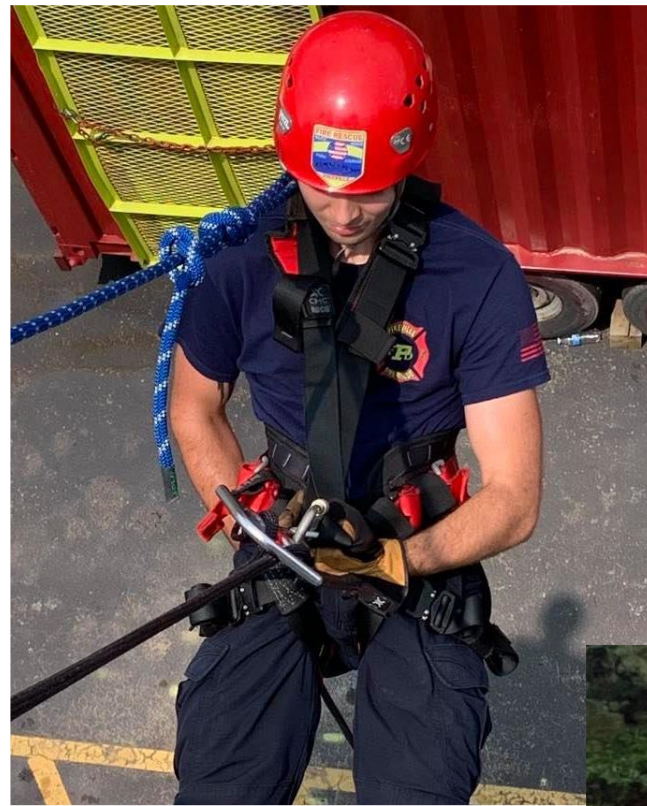
