

CITY OF PIKEVILLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING MINUTES MARCH 11, 2024 AT 6:00 P.M.

The Board of Commissioners for the City of Pikeville met in a regular called session on Monday, March 11, 2024. The meeting was held in the City Hall Meeting Room located at 243 Main Street, Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.

There being a quorum present, Mayor James A. Carter called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Members present at roll call were as follows:

MINUTES

The minutes for the previous special meeting held on February 26, 2024 were in each Commissioner's agenda package. There being no additions or corrections, Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve the minutes as prepared. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for discussion, there being none, the motion carried unanimously. 4-0

PAYMENT OF CITY BILLS

City Manager Reggie Hickman requested the approval to pay city bills in the amount of \$847,051.85. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for discussion, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 4-0
