There being no additions or corrections, Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve the minutes as prepared. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for discussion, there being none, the motion carried unanimously. 4-0

Brad Slone read several requests to the Commission for approval.

Consider a request to authorize and approve payment for Palmer Engineering Invoice No. 12798-6 for \$12,676.40 for the KEIP Build Ready Site project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 4-0
2. Consider a request to authorize and approve payment for Palmer Engineering Invoice No. 12927-1 for \$30,466.50 for the FEMA Mitigation Phase I project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 4-0

5. Consider a request to authorize and approve Bizzack Construction, LLC. Change Order No. 2 for \$1,036,060.00, as submitted, for the KEIP Build Ready Site project and grant the City Engineer the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none the motion unanimously. 4-0
