The Board of Commissioners for the City of Pikeville met in a regular called session on Monday, October 13, 2025. The meeting was held in the City Hall Meeting Room located at 243 Main Street, Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.

There being a quorum present, Mayor James A. Carter called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Members present at roll call were as follows:

**MINUTES**

The minutes for the previous special meeting held on September 29, 2025 were in each Commissioner's agenda package. There being no additions or corrections, Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve the minutes as prepared. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for discussion, there being none, the motion carried unanimously. 5-0

**BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR**

1. Consider a request to adopt a proclamation, as submitted, proclaiming October 24, 2025 as World Polio Day. Commissioner Powers made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, motion passed unanimously. 5-0
2. **Pikeville Fire Department Recognition:** The Commission recognized the Pikeville Fire Department for their recent mutual aid assistance provided to Elkhorn City, Kentucky, during a rope rescue operation. Representatives from Air Evac, including Pilot Dwayne Osborne and Flight Nurse Jasmine Adams involved in the mission, commended the Pikeville Fire Department for their professionalism, skill, and teamwork during the incident. They described the department as "exceptional,



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respectable, and not recognized as much as they truly should be.” The City Commission expressed their appreciation to the Pikeville Fire Department for their continued dedication, service, and commitment to excellence in ensuring the safety of not only the City of Pikeville but also surrounding communities.

### **PAYMENT OF CITY BILLS**

Mayor Carter requested the approval to pay city bills in the amount of \$1,949,835.16. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for discussion, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0

### **CITY ENGINEER**

Brad Slone read several requests to the Commission for approval.

1. Consider a request to authorize and approve payment for Precision Inc. Invoice No. 4 for \$44,391.47, as submitted, for the Cedar Creek Sewer Extension project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
2. Consider a request to authorize and approve payment for Boyd Asphalt Invoice No. 1307 for \$8,375.00, as submitted, for the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year Sidewalk repairs and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Powers made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
3. Consider a request to authorize and approve payment for Boca Enterprises Invoice No. 251009 for \$195,000.00 as submitted, for the Mullins Area Water Line Replacement project related to the February 2025 flood event and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
4. Consider a request to award a proposal to Palmer Engineering for \$44,760 for engineering services related to construction of the Bear Mountain Infrastructure Improvements project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
5. Consider a request to award a proposal to Palmer Engineering for \$93,270 for design and construction related services for the Bear Mountain Road Construction project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents pending approval by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. Commissioner Powers made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock



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seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0

6. Consider a request to award a bid to Commonwealth Building and Construction, the only bidder, for \$68,900.00 for the 113 Lakeview Drive Flood Rehabilitation project and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0

### CITY MANAGER

City Manager Reggie Hickman presented the Commission with the following items for approval:

1. Consider a request to adopt a proclamation, as submitted, proclaiming the month of October 2025 as City Government Month. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
2. Consider a request to authorize and approve Specialty Truck Sales and Service Change Order No. 335388 for \$750.00 and Ford GPC discount adjustment for \$350.00, as submitted, for 2025 Ford F450 4x4 Ambulance and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
3. Consider a request to authorize and approve payment for Specialty Truck Sales and Service Invoice No. 24416 for \$285,100.00, as submitted, for 2025 Ford F450 4x4 Ambulance vin 1FDUF4HT8SDA06237 and grant the Mayor the authority to sign and execute any and all necessary documents. Commissioner Hartsock made the motion to approve. Commissioner McNamee seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
4. Consider a request to adopt a proclamation, as submitted, proclaiming October 28, 2025 as National First Responders Day. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Shurtleff seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
5. Pursuant to KRS 61.810, consider a request for closed session for the purpose of discussion of economic development, legal, and personnel issues. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to approve. Commissioner Hartsock seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0
6. Consider a request to reconvene the meeting out of closed session into regular session. Commissioner McNamee made the motion to reconvene. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, meeting convened to regular session. 5-0
7. Consider a request to authorize advertisement for internal promotion to Sergeant for the Pikeville Police Department. Commissioner McNamee made the motion



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to approve. Commissioner Shurtleff seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for comments, there being none, the motion passed unanimously. 5-0

8. There being no further business to come before the Commission, Commissioner McNamee has made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Powers seconded the motion. Mayor Carter called for discussion, there being none, the meeting was adjourned. 5-0.
